Updating documentation for the List of ships under the shipowner's responsibility in the Union Registry

List of ships under the shipowner's responsibility: The shipowner shall provide a document listing the ships under the shipowner's responsibility, as well as their respective IMO ship identification number.

In case of changes to that list of ships, the shipowner shall inform the national administrator within 20 working days and provide it with an updated document, as well as with the name and IMO unique company and registered owner identification number of the new shipping company for each of the ships no longer under the shipowner's responsibility.

Explanation of the fields in the form

1. Account Holder/Organisation

The account holder is the legal or natural person responsible for the account in the Union Registry. Here you provide contact information and application information for the account holder.

2. Information for maritime operator holding account

List of ships under the shipowner's responsibility:

If the shipowner is responsible for the operation of the ships, a document listing the ships under the shipowner's responsibility must be submitted. The document must include a list of all the ships under the shipowner's responsibility as well as their respective IMO ship identification number.

In case of changes to that list of ships, the shipowner must inform the Swedish Energy Agency within 20 working days and submit an updated document. The shipowner must also provide the Swedish Energy Agency with the name and IMO unique company and registered owner identification number of the new shipping company for each of the ships no longer under the shipowner's responsibility.

Information on the Swedish Energy Agency's processing of personal data

The Swedish Energy Agency is responsible for the processing of personal data that is carried out as part of the Agency's work.

The regulations for the way in which personal data may be processed are contained in Regulation (EU) 2015/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and in the act (2018: 218) with additional provisions to the EU data protection regulation.

Personal data is all kinds of information that may refer directly or indirectly to a living natural person.

In order that the Swedish Energy Agency may process personal data, there must be legal grounds and a purpose for such processing. The legal grounds for the processing in question are exercise of authority. The purpose for processing the personal data submitted by you is for the account management and to administer the register under the Emissions Trading Act (2004: 1199) and Commission Regulation (EU) No 389/2013.

You have the right to request information about and gain access to the personal data relating to you. You can also request that incorrect data relating to you is corrected or to that data is deleted, or that the processing be restricted. In certain cases you may also have the right to object to the Swedish Energy Agency's processing of your personal data. If you feel that the Agency's processing of your personal data is in breach of the General Data Protection Regulation, you can submit a complaint to the Swedish Data Protection Authority.
